Shall the Board of Education of the Mexico School District No. 59, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Twenty-One Million Dollars (\$21,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to replace or upgrade heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems, roofing, and fire alarm systems District-wide; to construct, equip, and furnish a new classroom addition and renovate the kitchen at the Middle School; to construct a new secure entrance, complete Performing Arts theatre upgrades, install field turf, add tennis courts, and build, equip, and furnish a concession building at the High School; to renovate the Hawthorne Elementary School, Eugene Field Elementary School, and McMillan Early Learning Center playgrounds; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?
